IMDEA Water is a non-profit research Institute, promoted by the Regional Government of Madrid, to carry out research in water technologies. This Institute is part of the IMDEA network, the institutional framework that combines support from both the public and private sectors and harmonizes research with market demand, strengthening the presence of the private sector in science.

The position

This call is for hiring a Research Fellow, expert in economic, financial and institutional analysis of water to coordinate the activities of the different projects of this research line and in particular to contribute to the Service Contract to the European Commission for the Integrated Assessment of the EU River Basin Management Plans, and to the project CIANOALERT. The selected candidate will be offered a full-time contract (37.5 hours/week) for 24 months, renewable after passing a favorable evaluation, depending on the need of the projects and availability of funding..

The annual gross salary will be 42.000 Euros.

The work to be carried out include:

- The coordination of the integrated assessment of the EU River Basin Management Plans as defined in the Framework Contract signed by IMDEA and the European Commission's Clean Water Unit (DG Environment).
- The economic, financial and institutional analysis tasks of the CIANOALERT research Project for the Spanish Programme on R&TD&i oriented to societal challenges.
- Support to the preparation of the research proposals of the research line on economic and institutional analysis of water.
- The coordination of other research activities on economic financial and economic analysis of the research line and of the preparation of deliverables and other technical reports.

The starting day of the new employee is expected to be during May 2018.

Requirements

Candidates must satisfy the following requirements:

- Bachelor or graduate with a university Master's degree in economics, environmental sciences, resource economics or alike.
- 10+ year experience in research on economic, financial and institutional analysis of water.
- International peer-reviewed publications in the above matters.
- Language Proficiency: English and Spanish;

Required skills: good analytical and problem-solving capacity; capacity for the designing, monitoring and achievement of the work plan objectives; excellent communication skills and ability to prepare technical reports in English; ability to adapt to new working environments.
