IMDEA Water is a non-profit research Institute established by the Government of the Region of Madrid (Spain) to carry out research in water technologies. It is part of the research network called IMDEA that combines the financial support of both the public and private sector and harmonizes the research with market demand, enhancing private sector participation in science.

The position

This call is for hiring a **Research Assistant** to support in the national project “INREMEM 2.0: “Hybrid wastewater treatments based on recycled membranes with the objective of zero liquid discharge (ZLD)”. The selected candidate will be offered a full-time employment contract (37.5 hours / week) for an initial period **of 12 months**. The contract could be extended annually for project needs after a favourable assessment of performance and availability of resources.

Annual indicative gross salary: 20.000 - 23.000 euros.

The work to be performed will be focused on research on i) Assessing the environmental impact and economic viability of the different hybrid systems described in INREMEM 2.0 project proposal using life cycle assessment (LCA) tool and ii) economic and financial study.

The starting day of the new employee is expected to be in **July, 2019**.

Pre-requisites

Candidates must satisfy the following requirements:

- Holding the required qualification
- Fluency in English (spoken and written).
- Candidate’s profile: Academic training and/or working experience with LCA.
- Scientific papers.

Selection criteria

- Curriculum Vitae.
- Fitness of experience and expertise of the candidate to the open position.
- Experience and participation in national and European research projects.
- Experience in data analysis and reports writing in English.
- Those candidates with the best profile may be summoned for an interview.
